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RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL TRAINEES MUST OBSERVE THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS STRICTLY FAILURE TO DO SO WILL LEAD TO DISPLINARY ACTION AGAINST THEM.

1. Academic excellence.

All Trainees are expected to work hard for academic excellence proper time management will be expected.

2. Punctuality.

Strictly keep the time laid down for all the activities and observe the daily programs.

3. Class attendance.

All trainees must attend all classes for their courses as indicated in the timetable. In case of any need to be absent, permission should be sought from the Teacher on Duty, or the Head of Department.

4. Assemblies.

The institute shall conduct assemblies. The timing shall be communicated to all trainees through an internal memorandum. All Trainees must attend.

5. Cleanliness.

- a. All trainees must maintain high degree of personal hygiene and be decently dressed. b. Shaggy hair and un-tacked shirts are signs of carelessness and will not be allowed.
- c. Writing on walls, lecture chairs, tables and drawing boards is not allowed. d. Toilets should be used carefully and kept clean.
- e. Do not litter the compound.

6. Drinking and drug abuse.

Being drunk, bringing alcohol in the institute, taking any form of drug, smoking cigarettes and chewing Miraa(Khat) is forbidden such offences will receive appropriate punishment which may include expulsion.

NB/ - smoking of cigarettes is not allowed in the public

Trainees found stealing the institute's or other trainees' property will be considered as security risk and punishment may include expulsion from the institute.

10. Suspension.

Once a trainee is suspended, he/she will be required to be physically out of the institute. Violation of this rule, by illegal appearance on institute will gain the trainee more weeks.

On coming back from suspension, the trainee must report with a parent. Such a trainee will be required to sign a declaration of good conduct before readmission.

11. Fighting

Fighting is prohibited. Cases of fighting will be dealt with firmly and punishment will be suspension /expulsion.

12. Official trips.
