

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## ALL TRAINEES MUST OBSERVE THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS STRICTLY. FAILURE TO DO SO, WILL LEAD TO DISPLINARY ACTION AGAINST THEM.

#### 1. Academic excellence.

All trainees are expected to work hard for academic excellence. Proper time management will be expected.

#### 2. Punctuality.

Strictly keep the time laid down for all the activities and observe the daily programs.

#### 3. Class attendance.

All trainees must attend all classes for their courses as indicated in the timetable. In case of any need to be absent, permission should be sought from the Teacher on Duty, or the Head of Department or class teacher.

#### 4. Assemblies.

The institute shall conduct assemblies. The timing shall be communicated to all trainees through an internal memorandum. All trainees must attend.

#### 5. Cleanliness.

- a. All trainees must maintain high degree of personal hygiene and be decently dressed, **CAPS** and **MUFFINS** are not allowed.
- b. Shaggy hair, long un-kept hair, coloured hair and dreadlocks for men is prohibited in the Institute.
- c. Writing on walls, lecture chairs, tables and drawing boards is not allowed.
- d. Toilets should be used carefully and kept clean, staff washrooms are out of bound for trainees.
- e. Do not litter the compound.

#### 6. Alcohol and Drug Abuse.

Being drunk, bringing alcohol in the institute, taking any form of drug, smoking cigarettes and chewing Miraa is forbidden. Such offences will receive appropriate punishment which may include expulsion.

#### NB/ - smoking of cigarettes is not allowed in (Institution/Hostels)

#### Smoking and consumption of alcohol/drugs is harmful to your health.

#### 7. Security

- a. All trainees must use their valid Institute ID cards when leaving or entering the Institute compound
- b. All trainees must submit to security checkups at the main gate or as may be necessary
- c. No weapon or inflammable materials are allowed into the Institute
- d. Any form of threat is prohibited and shall deal with according to the Laws of the land.

#### 8. Examination

- a. The institute will subject bonafide trainees (registered trainees) to internal and external examinations.
- b. A trainee who is referred in one or two subjects in internal exams will be allowed to sit for supplementary examination(s) in the affected subject(s).
- c. A Trainee who fails to sit for scheduled Supplementary / Special examination without genuine reasons shall be treated as an academic indiscipline case and shall be subjected to academic policy.

#### 9. Sickness

Any trainee who falls sick must report to the dispensary for treatment or any other necessary action as advised.

#### 10. Care of property

- a. Trainees are required to take care of institute property and that of the other trainee. Any loss or damage should be reported immediately to the relevant authority/office
- b. Electricity and water taps should be put off/turned off when not needed.
- c. There should be no interference with electrical installation systems and electrical equipment & gadgets.

Any trainee violating the above rules will-

- 1. Pay twice the cost of appliance or fitting interfered with or materials destroyed and cost of fixing the same.
- 2. Be held totally responsible for any damage, loss or injuries caused by the irresponsible act.

#### 11. Co-curricular activities

Trainees are expected to participate in co-curricular activities. No trainee with indiscipline record will be allowed to participate in co-curricular activities.

#### 12. Theft.

Trainees found stealing the institute's or other trainees property will be considered as security risk and punishment may include expulsion from the institute.

#### 13. Suspension.

- i. Once a trainee is suspended he/she will be required to be physically out of the institute.
- ii. Violation of this rule, by illegal appearance the institute will warrant further disciplinary action.
- iii. On coming back from suspension the trainee must report with a parent/Guardian. Such a trainee will be required to sign a declaration of good conduct before readmission.

#### 14. Fighting

Fighting is prohibited. Cases of fighting will be dealt with firmly and punishment shall be suspension / expulsion.

NB/ fighting is a criminal offence and may involve the police.

#### 15. Official trips.

Once a trainee has been allowed to go on an official trip, he/she should not leave the rest without permission from the teacher in charge. When on an official trips the institute rules and regulations still prevail including observing time.

NB / any trainee who disappears will be responsible for their journey back and face disciplinary action.

#### 16. Discontinuation from Course

This may be due to:

- (a). voluntary discontinuation
- (b). Expulsion
- (C). Cheating or giving false details during admission
- (d). Indiscipline or gross misconduct
- (f). Failure to register for KNEC exams at the expected series can result to either:
  - i) Leave the Institution, or
  - ii) Wait for one academic year to register the exams.
- (g). Failure to sit for supplementary exams
- (h). Truancy

#### 17. Trainees Pregnancy

Trainees pregnancy is not allowed in the Institute, incase found pregnant the trainee will be allowed to proceed for maternity leave immediately.

18. Trainees are expected to observe workshop and safety rules always and protective gears.

#### 19. General

All trainees are expected to:-

- a. Show respect and co-operation to authority
- b. Carry out duties and communal work as assigned out to them as directed from time to time.
- c. Resist from carrying any type of weapon within the institute.
- d. Avoid using mobile phones in class
- e. Carry yourself in a disciplined manner within and around the institute.
- f. Avoid idling around the gate
- g. Avoid watching TV during class time
- h. Avoid causing public disturbance within the Institute
- i. Any violation disqualifies a trainee for vying for trainee leadership.
